
Q Am I approved to get my driver license?

.

A To see if you are approved to get your license, click here. [■■■■](#)(Illinois State Board of Education Driver Education Status Inquiry). Then enter your permit number without the dashes.

Q Are they changing the driving age to 18?

.

A The driving age has always been 18 UNLESS you pass a certified driver education class, in which case you can get your license at 16.

.

Q Who can the beginning driver legally drive with?

.

A To be driving legally, the beginning driver has to be driving with their Driver Education teacher, their parent or legal guardian, or a licensed driver who is approved by the parent and is over 21.

.

The experienced driver has to be licensed for at least one year for the type of vehicle being driven and must be sitting in the seat beside the beginning driver.

Q Can my son or daughter drive out of state on his/her permit?

.

A It is legal in Wisconsin IF the learning driver is 16 or over. All Illinois restrictions and rules apply.
