

Summary 2-8-10 Late-Arrival

At the February 8th late-arrival, HHS teachers reviewed Sophomore, Junior, and Senior student placements in classes for the 2010-2011 school year. Teachers gave recommendations for changes to student placements based on their academic history. This process ensures that students are enrolled in appropriate, rigorous classes that give them the best opportunity for success. This is an important step in the registration process that will help determine the 2010-2011 schedule. In addition to the review, teachers were shown Scantron Performance data from the second round of freshmen testing. Teachers are able to look at individual student progress as well as their class as a whole. Collectively, HHS students gained 17 points in the National Percentile Rankings in math and 11 points in reading in just a four month time period! This places HHS students in the 72nd percentile nationally in math, and in the 73rd percentile in reading. The next HHS late-arrival date is on February 22nd.
