

## **1-11-10 Summary**

At the HHS late arrival on January 11<sup>th</sup>, teachers were introduced to entering a test answer key into Scantron Achievement Series (SAS). SAS is a system that provides useful data to teachers when reviewing test scores such as item analysis of each question on the test. Teachers can use this data to make informed decisions regarding their instruction and testing strategies. SAS has an enormous capability of test-writing and data tools available that will be rolled out to teachers at the next several late-arrival meetings. After the initial introduction to the system, teachers reconvened into their Professional Learning Teams (PLT's) to continue the process of writing essential questions to address "Must-Knows" in their courses. Teachers entered assessments into Achievement Series and used the system to share it with other members of their PLT. In the next days and weeks, students will be given assessments which will allow teachers to view data on the progress of their students. Several departments have already taken the initiative to enter their final exams into SAS so they may readily use the data to critically analyze their exams. HHS will conduct its next late-arrival on February 8<sup>th</sup>.
