A note about elective requests:

For a variety of reasons, one of your preferred electives may not be available next year (it may be because there are not enough open seats in a particular class, the class may not run due to a low number of requests, or there may be a conflict in your schedule with another required core class).

During the week of January 16, 2018, high school counselors will meet individually with 8th grade students at each middle school. At that meeting, students will have the opportunity to select alternate elective requests in case their preferred requests are not available.

A note about summer school:

There are four classes offered to incoming Freshmen in summer school. Students can register for one six-week summer session or two three-week summer sessions. You **MUST COMMIT** to the entire duration of the summer school term(s) and have your own transportation. These courses are offered to freshmen:

1. Art Fundamentals (six-week summer session)
2. Honors World History (six-week summer session)
3. Culinary Arts I (three-week summer session)*
4. Automotive Technology I (three-week summer session)*

*Course may not run if not enough student requests are submitted.

There are many reasons that incoming freshmen may want to enroll in summer school to take one of these classes:

- Art Fundamentals is the prerequisite for all other Art classes. By taking this class in summer school, students will be able to request other Art classes their freshman year.

This summer, course offering will be offered at Dundee-Crown High School in Carpentersville and Hampshire High School in Hampshire.

Once finalized, summer school information will be added to the Freshmen web site and distributed through each middle school.
