



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q When does Online Registration for returning students open?

A April 3, 2017

Q Did my high school student already register during the school year?

A No, high school students selected courses for the upcoming school year. Course selection and registration are two different processes.

Q I moved during the last year, what do I need to do?

A If you have moved in the last calendar year, you must provide proof of address of your new address (see next question).

Q What proof of address documents are accepted?

A Acceptable proof of address documents guidelines include:

1 Requirements for Homeowners: (One document from the following list is required)

- Most recent real estate tax bill
- Closing statement
- Mortgage documentation
- Closing disclosure/HUD-1

2 Requirements for Renters: (Two document will be required)

- **Current** lease agreement signed and dated by landlord and one document from the following list:
 - Utility bill
 - Home or apartment insurance certificate
 - State of Illinois automobile registration
 - Receipt for city vehicle sticker
 - Cable television or home internet bill
 - Bank statement
 - Pay stub
 - Medical billing statement

If you are not a homeowner or a renter and you reside within District 300 boundaries: Contact your school's main office to obtain necessary documents to be completed for address verification.
