

Dear Parent/Guardian:

As a reminder, the Illinois State Board of Education uses the SAT *Suite of Assessments* as the state-funded college-entrance test administered to juniors. District 300 offers several practice assessments for students to gain some crucial SAT practice and to monitor progress towards maximizing achievement on the SAT. This list of practice tests includes the PSAT 8/9 (eighth grade), PSAT 8/9 (freshmen), and PSAT 10 (sophomores). Additionally this fall, both sophomore and junior students are given the PSAT/NMSQT, which is a practice version that can also provide scholarship and recognition opportunities for the highest performing students.

**Testing Schedule for High School 2018-19:**

**Fall Date:** Wednesday, October 10, 2018

- **Who attends:** Freshmen (PSAT 8/9) Sophomores and Juniors (PSAT/NMSQT)
  - *Seniors will not be in attendance*
- **Testing Schedule:** The school day will start as normal, at 7:30am. Testing is anticipated to be done for most students by 12:15 p.m. Lunch will be available for students on the testing day, after testing. An early release schedule will be used, with busses leaving the school at 12:45pm.
- **Score Reports:** We anticipate receiving the scores in December.
