The demographic study produced three different enrollment trend scenarios:

- Scenario A (Low Growth Model)
- Scenario B (Normal Growth Model)
- Scenario C (High Growth Model)

For the purposes of boundary adjustment the district used scenario B.


HMS BOUNDARY OPTION 1 – DMS NORTH 90

Description - Expand the DMS boundary to include the north of 90 section from HMS boundary






HMS BOUNDARY OPTION 3 – DMS RAILROAD

Description - Expand the DMS boundary to the railroad




