Dear Parents and Guardians,

Recently, the state adjusted the School Code in regards to state assessments. Students who have been identified through the IEP process to take the alternative assessment (Dynamic Learning Maps) now have the option to also take the state's regular assessment (SAT).

Section 2-3.64a-5 of the School Code provides "Students receiving special education services whose individualized educational programs identify them as eligible for the alternative State assessments nevertheless shall have the option of taking this State's regular assessment that includes a college and career ready determination, which shall be administered in accordance with the eligible accommodations appropriate for meeting these students' respective needs."

The SAT is a globally recognized college admissions test given to current 11th grade students. This rigorous test is designed to assess a student's skills in literacy, writing, and math to determine readiness for college.
